Registration at Chase Lake Pass, 10 miles north of Medina on County Road 68. At the Chase Lake NWR sign, turn west on 26th St SE. Travel 7 miles west (the last 4 miles are prairie trail) and 1 mile south to the Chase Lake Prairie Pass. If there have been recent rains, an alternate route is to travel 3 miles west on 26th St. SE and then turn north 2 miles, west 4.5 miles, and 4 miles south to Chase Lake Prairie Pass. The route(s) will be marked; follow the signs.

In case of inclement weather, events will be held at the Chase Lake Visitors Center in Medina.
